ABSTRACT

Modern era's changing lifestyle along with changing food culture and also depending upon one's body constitution *Amlapitta* is one of the most common symptom (disease) found in the society. Though it is not a big life threatening issue, however runs long time if treated symptomatically. Antacids are one of the most widely used medicines all over the world. By taking antacids the acid which is the first line of immunity, is neutralized and the person becomes more prone to various infections. In *Ayurveda*, we concentrate more on *Agni vruddhi* and *Aam pachana* by various means. Ayurvedic management can answer with its own principals of *Dosha*, *Dushya*, *Srotas*, *Agni* etc. Here and attempt is made to find the safe and curative remedy for

Amlapitta, in form of Eladi Churna.

INTRODUCTION

Vitiation of *Agni* in *Amashaya* (stomach) due to various factors, causes *Amlapitta*. Some of the common causes are - fasting, eating in- between meals, worry, hurry, spicy foods etc are some *pitta* vitiating factors. These factors derange the *pachaka pitta* (digestive enzymes etc.) and as a result *pachaka pitta* vitiates. Thus developed condition is called *Amlapitta*. *Amlapitta* is correlated with Acid Reflux Diseases like Gastritis, Dyspepsia, Heartburn, Hyperacidity, Hypoacidity etc. as described in modern sciences. Sixty percent of the adult population will experience some type of gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD) within a 12 month period and 20 to 30% will have weekly symptoms.

AIMS: To evaluate the efficacy of *Eladi Churna* in the management of *Amlapitta*.

DISEASES REVIEW

Kashayapa samhita is a first available *Samhita* describing *Amlapitta*. *Amlapitta* was not considered as a separate disease entity in any of the three old treatise of Ayurveda but it was mentioned as a symptom in a good number of places by Acharya *Charaka*.

Nidana of *Amlapitta*

Aharja Hetu: Viruddha Bhojana, Sandusta Bhojana, Vidahi Bhojana, Vidagdh Bhojana.

Viharaj Hetu: Divaswapana, Atisnana and Avagahana

Manasika Hetu: Kama, Krudha, Lobha, Moha, Irshya, Shoka, Bhaya

Purvarupa of *Amlapitta:* Acharya *Charaka* has mentioned some Purvarupa of *Grahani* like *Trishna*, *Alasya*, loss of Bala, *Annavidaha*, *Gauravata* etc. These symptoms may be considered as the *Purvarupa* of *Amlapitta*.

Rupas (Symptoms and Signs) of Amlapitta

Avipaka, Klama, Utklesha, Tikta/Amla Udgara, Guarav, Hrid- Kantha Daha, Aruchi.

SAMPRAPTI OF AMLAPITTA

According to *Acharya Kashaypa*, indulgence of *Nidana* causes, the Dosha prakopa especially of Pitta Dosha. This *Dosha Prakopa* creates *Mandagni*, and due to *Mandagni* ingested food becomes *Vidagdha* and *Shuktibhava*. This *Vidagdha* and *Shuktbhava* of food create *Amlata* in Amashaya. This condition is called *Amlapitta*.

TREATMENT FOR AMLAPITTA

As per *Ayurveda* line of treatment for *Amlapitta* are the drugs which are *Tikta Rasa* dominant and having *Pachana* property.

DRUG REVIEW

Eladi churna: It is recommended in Yoga Ratnakara for the Amlapitta.

ELADI CHURNA

Name of drug - Eladi churna

Drug formulation - Powder

Dose -10 gm/ day twice in divided dose with water

DISCUSSSION

Amlapitta is a very common disease that everyone usually suffers once in the life.

PROBABALE ACTION OF ELADI CHURNA IN AMLAPITTA

DOSHA: The chief *Dosha* involved in the *Amlapita* is *Pitta & Kapha*. Table wise distribution shows that the majority of the drugs have *Madhura Rasa* (80%) *Madhura Vipaka* (60%) *Sheeta Virya* (50%) *KaphaVata Shamaka* (40%) & *Tridosha Shamaka* Property (30%). *Amalaki, Chandana, Ela, Vanshlochana* has cooling effect due to their *Shita Virya* property.

Madhura Rasa, Madhura Vipaka, Shita Virya and Laghu, Snigdha guna of Vanshlochana has been proved Pittashamaka, Vatshamaka, Dhatuvridhikara.

DUSHYA: In Amlapitta, Rasadhatu is affected. The property of Deepana - Pachana Karma and Tikta Rasa of the drugs will directly act on the vitiated Rasa Dahtu.

AGNI & AMA: Most of the drugs have Tikta Rasa property (90%), Sama Pitta will become Nirama and Agni will be increased. In *Amlapitta* Acharya Charaka says that Manadagni and Ajirna creates Annavisha. When it gets mixed with Pitta Dosha it creates Pittaja Vyadhis like Amlapitta. Trigandha or Trijata has Ruksha, Ushna, Laghu and Pittakrata properties which help in formation of Nirama Pitta. So, the Tikta Rasa property of the drugs purifices the Pitta by Niramikarana. Acharyas of Ayurveda have also given the treatment of Pittaja disease. They said that first of all Tikta Rasa Dravyas have been used for Niramikarana of Pitta and then after Madhura Rasa & then Kashaya Rasa used for Paittika Vyadhis.

CONCLUSION

Hence it can be concluded that *Eladi churna* can be considered as very useful and effective Ayurvedic combination in the management of Amlapitta.
